Keurig style coffee maker

Microwaves (1,000 watts max)

Refrigerators (5 cu. ft. max)

**Computer equipment** 

TV's

**Battery operated candles** 

Fire treated curtains & flags \* must have tags and documentation meeting <u>NFPA 701</u>

All electrical devices must be <u>UL Approved</u>

All electrical devices must be plugged directly into wall outlet or power strip.
